Do you have what it takes to be considered an Ohio Master Teacher?

Do you need to renew your Master Teacher designation?

Do you want to be designated as a “consistently high performing teacher”?

Do you...

- *Have at least nine years of teaching experience and work at least 120 days as a teacher?*
 - **Yes?** Starting on your Master Teacher portfolio now will give you time to add, edit, and reflect carefully on your portfolio contents and written narratives.
- *Want to be designated as a “consistently high performing teacher” which would exempt you from the requirement to complete any additional coursework/professional development for the renewal of a professional educator license for the next renewal cycle?*
 - **Yes?** With the Master Teacher designation, you are eligible to apply for the senior or lead professional educator license. A senior or lead professional educator license is one way to be considered for the designation of “consistently high performing teacher”. (Additional requirements apply to the lead professional educator license and the “high performing teacher” designation.)
- *Participate in the OTES (Ohio Teacher Evaluation System)?*
 - **Yes?** You are part of the way to having a Master Teacher portfolio for submission and scoring.
- *Want the opportunity for collaborative reflection on aspects of your teaching?*
 - **Yes?** You meet with a small group of teacher colleagues from other buildings and other districts to share your experiences and reflect on them together.
- *Want to participate in professional development aligned to your teaching practices?*
 - **Yes?** Contact hours are provided for the professional development sessions and also for successful designation as a Master Teacher by the scoring committee.
