What is A Parent Mentor?

A Parent Mentor is a parent of a child with a disability, and is a support network to school districts, and parents of children with disabilities or parents who have educational concerns about their children.

The Goal of the Parent Mentor:

<u>GUIDE</u> families through the special education process, including right and responsibilities.

<u>LISTEN</u> and provide support to families and educators on an individual basis.

<u>PROVIDE INFORMATION</u> and resources to families including education laws, district programs and services, and community resources.

<u>ATTEND</u> Individual Education Program (IEP) meetings and other meetings on parent or staff request.

Reasons to Call the Parent Mentor:

- I'm worried about my child moving from one school to the next.
- I feel alone and wish I could talk to another parent who understands my concerns.
- I have many questions about my child's education but I forgot to ask them at the school meetings.
- I would like to be more involved in planning my child's education.
- I am worried about my child's progress and don't know what to do.
- I feel like nobody is listening to my concerns about my child.
- I would like to have someone attend and support me at IEP and/or other meetings at school.

I understand what families go through to help their children succeed educationally and socially and value the support parents can offer one another!
