NEW KRA SCORESHEET GUIDANCE DOCUMENT

We wanted to make you aware that a new guidance document was released recently regarding the new Scoresheet Data option to upload KRA data within the Ohio K Ready system. Individuals that attended the KRA trainings this school year were made aware of the new Scoresheet option, but have not yet seen the guidance document. Please see Resource [Link 9.14.18](#) for the KRA Scoresheet Guide. Anyone trained prior to this year, may not yet be aware of the new feature.

KRA Scoresheet Description:

There's a new way to enter student scores and it's available now! You can print out a scoresheet for each student and bubble it in with scores throughout the window (similar to a Scantron). Then, capture an image of your scoresheets with the secure KRA app (iOS or Android versions only) and the scores will be automatically entered into the Ready for Kindergarten Online system! You can find the Scoresheet print button next to each student's name in the Ready for Kindergarten Online system. Make sure you have the most updated version of the KRA app on your iOS or Android device!

CTE ONE-DAY EMIS WORKSHOP REGISTRATION NOW OPEN
