

# Ohio Principal Evaluation System Training



**What:** This two-day training on the Ohio Principal Evaluation System (OPES) will assist districts/schools in meeting HB 153 evaluation requirements for principals. The first day of training will focus on the different OPES components. The second day of training will focus on the summative evaluation component of the OPES. Attendance at both sessions is mandatory if a district wants to use the OPES model to meet the requirements of HB 153. Completion certificates will be provided at the end of Day 2.

**Why:** Developing a system for principal evaluation that meets the new requirements of HB 153 is required for ALL school districts. ODE has developed an evaluation model and resource packet to assist school districts in this work. This training will focus on how to use the model to develop a new system of principal evaluation that meets ORC requirements.

**Who:** District teams (superintendent, principals, HR) are encouraged to attend but all participants are welcome.

**When/Where:** March 15, 2012 and April 18, 2012 at the ESC of Lake Erie West, ESC, 2275 Collingwood Blvd., Toledo, OH 43620.

**Time:** Registration at 8:30, Training starts promptly at 9 and will end at 2:30

**Cost:** \$125 per participant includes two days of training, lunches and all training materials.

**Parking:** The first two rows of parking at the ESC of Lake Erie West are reserved for short-term parking. Please park in the last three rows of the main lot. Parking is also available in the adjacent lot or in back of the building.
