



School Safety Questions for School Stakeholders

1. Does the school have a current safety plan?
2. To what extent is the comprehensive safety plan being implemented, monitored, and updated as needed?
3. Does the school have a team assigned specifically to student safety?
4. Have school administrators and security personnel been trained on crisis management?
5. Are there anonymous reporting and response procedures where students, staff, and families can report concerning behaviors or potential threats?
6. Do students know how to report suspicious incidents?
7. What safety-related programs currently exist within the school?
8. Do current programs address prevention, as well as intervention?
9. Is there enough of an effort towards prevention of safety challenges – Are students taught safety procedures? Are there anti-bullying programs in place? Are troubled students quickly referred to professionals who can help them? Do all teachers and educational support personnel "know the drill?"
10. How many school counselors, school psychologists, school social workers, and school nurses does the school have?
11. What type of building safety measures are in place?
12. Does the school have other physical security measures in place?
13. What safety improvements has the school made?
14. What drills are in place to help students and staff respond to emergencies?
15. How are families notified if there is a school safety threat or incident?
16. Do all classroom and office doors lock?
